6TH GRADE ORIENTATION “WEB DAY” IS THURSDAY, AUGUST 23RD

We are very excited that your student will be attending middle school in Farmington this year and we look forward to meeting him or her on **Orientation Day – Thursday, August 23rd, 2018**. As you may know, our school participates in the nationwide W.E.B. Program, an organization whose primary purpose is to help sixth graders feel more comfortable and to help them achieve success in their first year of middle school.

The WEB sixth grade orientation and transition program is designed to both welcome and support sixth graders by assigning them an 8th grade WEB Leader as a mentor during this first year. This WEB Leader is a responsible older student who was hand selected from a large pool of applicants and has met the qualifications of being a good role model and a positive leader on our campus. Below is some important information about orientation:

1. Bus slips will be mailed in the upcoming future directly to your residence. This will include your student’s personalized transportation information for August 23. It will list the time and location of the bus pickup and drop off for this event. If this information appears inaccurate once you receive it, please call the main office at 651-460-1500
2. Should you wish to transport your student, this event is scheduled to take place from 8:00 a.m. until 12:30 p.m.
3. Your student is encouraged not to bring backpacks, purses or other like items as the day is quite active.

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ATTENTION PARENTS OF 7TH GRADE STUDENTS – REQUIRED IMMUNIZATIONS

We are planning for the start of the 2018-19 school year and want to inform you that your child is due for booster immunizations required for 7th grade enrollment.

Effective September 1, 2014 Tetanus Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap) and Meningococcal immunizations have been added to the requirements.

Proof of the following immunizations or a notarized form indicating you are conscientiously objecting to more immunizations must be provided to the health office no later than the first day of school on September 4, 2018.

2 Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR) (1st dose must be after age 1.)

1 Tetanus Diphtheria Pertussis (Tdap) Booster given after age 11 (New)

3 Polio Immunizations

3 Hepatitis B Immunizations

2 Chicken Pox (Varicella) (given after 1 year of age and at least 28 days apart) or date of disease verified by MD

1 Meningococcal Immunization (given at age 11-12) (New)

Please contact your physician to schedule an appointment to get these taken care of at any time. The offices get busy in the summer. If your child is going out for sport next fall you might also want to consider getting their sports physical done as well.



MEDICATION PERMISSION FORMS

Medication Permission forms are required annually for your child to receive medication through the health office. This includes prescription and over the counter medications. [You can find a variety of forms HERE](#). Download the appropriate form for your doctor to complete.

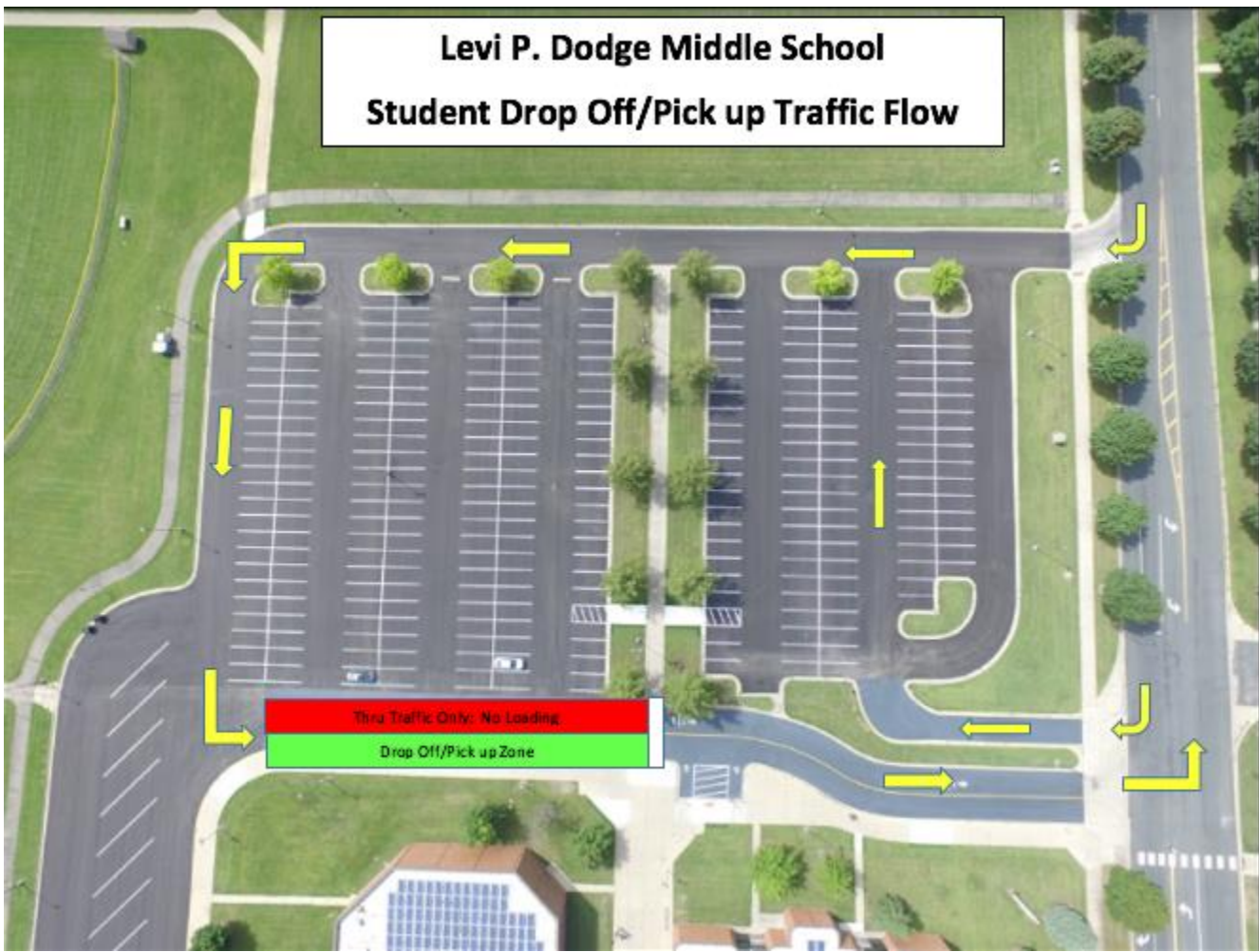


STUDENT DROP OFF, PICK UP, AND TRAFFIC FLOW

With close to 900 students and staff that come to Dodge Middle School every day it takes the concerted and consistent efforts of everyone to ensure a safe experience. The image below indicates the flow of traffic that all visitors need to follow when dropping off or picking up your student before/after school.

Additional items:

- Students dropped off after 7:35 a.m. or picked up during the day need to do so at the Main Entrance
- The speed limit on 208th street is 20 M.P.H. from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday-Friday.
- The speed limit in the parking lot is 10 M.P.H.



FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL IS TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 4th (Day A)

- The school day begins at 7:35 a.m. and ends at 2:25 p.m.
- The office is open from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday
- Students do not need to bring their band instruments or PE clothing on the first day of school
- Students are welcome to bring their iPads on the first day of school if they kept it over the summer

MIDDLE SCHOOL SWIMMING

The Farmington Middle School Boys and Girls Swim program is open to students in grades 6 to 8. The program will be Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday from 2:45pm - 3:45pm beginning September 4th at Dodge Middle School. There will be a final meet on October 17th. A shuttle bus will be provided to transport BMS students to Dodge immediately after school. The cost of the program is \$140 per swimmer. For the girls, an additional fee of approximately \$50 will be collected at the start of the season to cover the cost of a suit and cap. Because girls' swimming is a fall sport, the middle school girls will have the opportunity to compete against other middle school programs. Boys will have the opportunity to practice and participate in inner-squad meets.
