Angst is a film that explores anxiety, its causes, effects and what we can do about it. The filmmaker's goal is to have a global conversation and raise awareness around anxiety. Angst features candid interviews with kids and young adults who have had experienced anxiety and what they've learned about it.

The film includes discussions with mental health experts about the causes of anxiety and its sociological effects, as well as help, resources and tools.

A question and answer session will follow the film. Parents can ask their questions to local mental health professionals. Local mental health agencies will share resources.
