

7th Grade Washington D.C. Trip 2019



All 7th graders are welcome to consider a great opportunity to go on a school-sponsored trip to Washington, D.C.! The trip will occur in June 2019 (right after school ends), and is organized by BMS, DMS, and the educational travel group Washington Workshops.

For interested students, the process includes: 1) completing an application, 2) writing an essay, and 3) attending a short interview with a teacher and students from last year's trip. Applications are available from your History teacher and must be turned in by November 8. The trip is limited to 20 - 25 students from each school and students will be selected based on their essay, interview, and the recommendations of their current 7th grade teachers.

The cost of the trip will be approximately \$2,000, which includes airfare, lodging, ground transportation, meals, and all entrance fees to exhibits and museums. We recognize this cost is significant and may unfortunately deter some families and students. However, students and families from past trips have attested that the trip is an excellent value and a one-of-a-kind experience.
